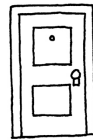
Here Comes March!

Read the poem aloud. Then reread it, and invite children to call out the final word in each sentence.

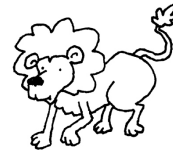
Here comes March, ready to **roar**,



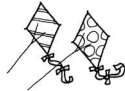
As February goes out the **door**.
